SAFETY OF YOUR CHILDREN

We fully comply with all Government legislation, and have a Safeguarding policy in place. We ensure that all those leading children's groups have undergone a satisfactory DBS check and have Public Liability insurance cover in place.



















FACILITIES

The Centre has two halls, a kitchen, four toilets including disabled facilities. Each toilet has its own wash hand basin, soap dispenser and a hand drier. The disabled toilet also has a baby changing unit.

The hamstone walled grassed garden at the back overlooks an orchard, ideal for Teddy Bears Picnics. There are no on-street parking restrictions along the road.



MAIN HALL

This is a lovely large hall (c 96 sq metres) with a very high ceiling and great for games and generally having fun. The oak floor is particularly suited to dance and gym activities.

The hall is lit by LED spots which can be dimmed, and heated by wall infrared heaters, providing economical and instant heat.

Both the Main Hall and the Rear Hall have independent access to the toilets and kitchen.



REAR HALL

There is a stable door in the hall into the kitchen. The hall has Youth Club equipment that can be used by all e.g. table tennis, pool and table football. Like the Main Hall it has infrared wall heaters

The Centre has 10 melamine folding tables and 40 stackable chairs which can be used in either hall.



KITCHEN

This is equipped with a double oven, hob, microwave, kettle, water heater and small fridge/freezer. A hot water heater supplies the sink and all washing up liquid and tea towels are provided. The cupboards are well stocked with crockery, cutlery, cups and plates, saucepans etc. Cooking facilities are all electric.

Newly installed, the kitchen is ideal for preparing meals and snacks and holding simple cookery lessons.



OUTDOOR SPACE

The Centre has a walled grassed garden at the back overlooking apple orchards, ideal for Teddy Bear picnics, games and story telling.

The Centre is opposite the Sports & Recreation Ground where you can find an adventure play park, a BMX track, a skate park and lots of grass to run around on!



BIRTHDAY PARTIES

The Centre is an ideal place for children's birthday parties. The Main Hall can house a large bouncy castle and other equipment for entertainment whilst the rear hall which has direct access to the kitchen can be set out with tables for the birthday feast. Please note that we only accept parties up to the age of 12.

When you hire the Centre for a party, you have access to the whole of the Centre - both halls and all facilities. The kitchen is fully equipped for catering







BROADBAND

The Centre has secure ultrafast fibre broadband kindly provided by Gigaclear under their Community Hub scheme. This makes it ideal for streaming and watching films with ease, or following internet training courses. The Centre has a MusicLicence from PPL/PRS for recorded music.

HEALTH & SAFETY

We take the safety of our customers very seriously. The Centre is protected by a Fire Alarm system with heat sensors and smoke alarms. There is emergency lighting and two sets of fire escape doors.

Regular H & S Risk Assessments and building checks are undertaken and there is exterior CCTV for building security. A First Aid box is provided in the kitchen together with an Accident Book.

All individuals leading groups and volunteers are DBS checked and if they are a professional instructor, required to show their qualification certificates. The Centre has Public Liability cover in its own right and all group leaders are required to have PL insurance of their own to cover their own activities.
